Online applications are invited for admission to the following courses offered by the College for the Academic Session 2024-25. Candidates desirous of seeking admission are required to register themselves online on the College website www.miercollege.in. and fill up the Online Application Form with an application fee of Rs.1500/-as per the procedure provided on the portal. The details are also provided on the website for the convenience of the applicants. Applicants facing difficulty in submitting the online application forms or seeking any clarification and assistance can visit the College Admission Cell between 10 am to 4 pm. Candidates can also submit the downloaded form and all documents along with a Demand Draft for Rs. 1500/- in favour of "MIER College of Education" payable at Jammu through Registered Post/Speed Post/Courier:

Eligibility for admission to B.Ed. & M.Ed.

Admission to the B.Ed. Programme shall be open to candidates with atleast 50 % marks (45 % for SC/ST Candidates) either at the Bachelor's Degree ($10 + 2 + 3$ pattern) or at the Master's Degree in Sciences / Social Sciences / Humanities, Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or Technology with Specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks (50% for SC/ST candidates) or any other qualification equivalent thereto from a recognized University.	 A candidate seeking admission to M.Ed. Programme should have obtained atleast 50 % marks in the aggregate (45 % for candidates belonging to SC/ST Category) or an equivalent grade in any of the following programmes: B.Ed. 4-year Integrated B.A. B.Ed., B.Sc. Eligibility for admission to B.Ed. Spl. Education (ID) & M.Ed. Spl. Education (ID)

Admission to the B.Ed. Special Education (ID) Programme shall be open to candidates with atleast 50 % marks (45 % for SC/ST Candidates) either at the Bachelor's Degree ($10 + 2 + 3$ pattern) or at the Master's Degree in Sciences / Social Sciences / Humanities, Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or Technology with Specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks (50% for SC/ST candidates) or any other qualification equivalent thereto from a recognized University.	 The admission for the degree of M.Ed. Spl. Education (ID) shall be open to: a) A candidate who has successfully passed B.Ed. Spl. Education (ID) with minimum 50% marks from a recognized university or any other degree considered equivalent to B.Ed. Spl. Education (ID) from an affiliating University and / or teaching department under any University recognized by UGC with RCI registration. b) A candidate who has successfully passed the B.Ed. General Course and has successfully completed Diploma in Special Education (ID) recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India

Credish (G-Yairs)	 with minimum 50 percent marks in each course. c) A candidate who has successfully passed the B.A./ B.Sc. / B.Com. / B.Ed. Spl. Education (ID) 4 Years Integrated Course with minimum 50% marks or an equivalent grade from a recognized University with RCI Registration. d) Candidate should have valid RCI registration.

Eligibility for admission to 2-Year M.A. Programmes in Psychology (Clinical & Counselling), Political Science, Sociology and English.

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognized University with at least 40% aggregate marks (36% for SC/ST candidates).

Eligibility for admission to 4-Year Under- Graduate Programmes

Candidate seeking admission to the Bachelor of Arts (Honours / Honours with Research) Programmes must have obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for candidates belonging to reserved categories) in Higher Secondary Part-II Examination (under 10+2 pattern) of Jammu and Kashmir State Board of School Education, Central Board of Secondary Education or an examination recognised as equivalent thereto from any other recognised Board.

Eligibility for admission to 1-Year Diploma in Guidance & Counselling

A candidate seeking admission to the Diploma in Guidance and Counselling must fulfill the following conditions:

- (a) He/ She must be a graduate from any University recognized by the UGC with a minimum of 45% marks in the aggregate or an equivalent grade thereto
- (b) There is no upper age limit for seeking admission to the programme

Note:

- 1. The candidates who have appeared or appearing in the qualifying examination can also apply.
- 2. The candidates are advised to deposit their marks certificates of the final year/semester of the qualifying examination either in the College or through Registered/Speed Post or Scanned copy through e-mail after the declaration of the result. However, their admission shall be regularized after submission of the requisite documents such as final year Marks card/Provisional certificate.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Admission to B.Ed., M.Ed., B.Ed. Spl. Education (ID), M.Ed. Spl. Education (ID), 2-Year M.A. Programmes in Political Science, Psychology (Clinical & Counselling), Sociology & English and 4-Year Under-Graduate (Honours / Honours with Research) Programmes in Psychology, Political Science, English, Sociology and History shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination from any recognised Board / University / Institution. However, the candidate must have appeared in the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) conducted by the National Testing agency (NTA). OR any other mode to be prescribed by the Competent Authority of the College / University of Jammu/J&K Government from time to time.
- ii) Admission to Diploma in Guidance and Counselling shall be made on the basis of academic merit in the qualifying examination from any recognized University / Institution or any other criteria prescribed by the Competent Authority of the College from time to time.

Reservation of Seats

Reservation of seats shall be as per Reservation Policy of Jammu& Kashmir Government/ University of Jammu as notified from time to time.

Left Over Seats

In case of a vacant seat under a reserved category for want of eligible candidates the same shall be offered to the candidate of non-reserved category (open merit) in order of merit.

Documents to be submitted at the time of admission

- i) B.Ed., M.Ed., B.Ed. Special Education (ID), M.Ed. Spl. Education (ID), M.A. in Political Science, Psychology (Clinical & Counselling), English and Sociology Programmes:
 - 1. Secondary School or an equivalent examination certificate
 - 2. Marks Certificates of the qualifying examination
 - 3. Degree / Provisional Certificate issued by the institution last attended
 - 4. Category Certificate along with Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority (if applicable)
 - 5. Migration Certificate for the candidates not registered with MIER College of Education (Autonomous). However, the candidates may produce the Migration Certificate within a period of 30 days from the date of their admission
 - 6. Affidavits as per the specimen available with the Admission Cell of the College

ii) 4-Year Under-Graduate (Honours / Honours with Research) Programmes :

All the selected candidates shall submit the following self-attested documents at the time of their admission to the Bachelor of Arts (Honours / Honours with Research) in Psychology, Political Science, English, Sociology and History Courses:

- i) Matriculation or equivalent examination certificate
- ii) Marks Certificate of each part of the qualifying examination i.e. 10 + 2
- iii) Provisional and Migration/Transfer Certificate issued by the Institution/ Board last attended
- iv) Category Certificate (If applicable) issued by the Competent Authority as per the latest SRO issued by the J&K Government
- v) Certificate of being "**Domicile**" of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir issued by the Competent Authority (in case a candidate seeks admission under reserved category)
- vi) Affidavits duly attested by a First-Class Magistrate or a Notary Public as per the specimen available in the Admission Cell of the College.

Important Note

The certificates of candidates belonging to reserved categories who are permanent residents of the Union Territory of J&K shall not be entertained if these do not conform to the latest SRO/Order issued by the J&K Government for the purpose. In case, a candidate claims admission under reserved category but does not attach the requisite certificate in support of his/her claim with the Application Form and if found otherwise eligible, will be considered under Open Merit Category. No certificate or attested copy thereof will be entertained after the last date notified for admission. The claim of the candidate for consideration under any reserved category with "under process certificate" of category shall not be entertained.

Annual Fee

The annual fee for the session 2024-25 shall be charged as under:

i) The candidates shall have to pay fee annually.	
ii) Registration and Eligibility fee (if applicable)	= Rs.1000/-
iii) Degree fee (to be remitted to the University of Jammu)	= Rs. 980/-
iv) Diploma fee for Guidance & Counselling Course	= Rs. 600/-

Refund of Fee

Candidates applying for withdrawal of admission shall be entitled for refund of fee deposited as per the UGC guidelines given as under:

Category	Percentage of Refund of fee	Time period (withdrawal of admission)
1	100 %	15 days or more before the last date of admission has been notified
2	90 %	Less than 15 days before the last date of admission
3	80%	15 days or less after the last date of admission
4	50 %	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after the last date of admission
5	00 %	More than 30 days after the last date of admission

Note:

- i) **Rs. 1000/-** shall be deducted as Processing Fee in case of (1) above.
- ii) Fee shall be refunded to the candidate within 15 days after the candidate has submitted the written application to the College.

IMPORTANT

- The College shall recognize the degrees of only those Universities which are recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC). The degrees obtained through Study Centres / Franchises of any University except Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) shall not be recognized.
- ii) In view of rampant reports of fake certificates and fake Universities, College reserves the right of screening the certificates of applicants seeking admission who have obtained their qualifying degrees from Universities other than the University of Jammu and evaluating their recognition

Award of Degree

The degree shall be awarded to the successful candidates by the University of Jammu. However, the Marks, Provisional and Migration Certificates shall be issued by the College

Award of Diploma

The Diploma in Guidance & Counselling shall be issued by the College duly signed by the Controller of Examinations and the Principal.
