SIGNING OF MOUs

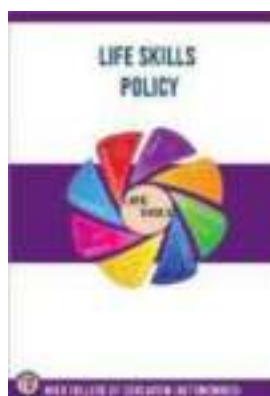

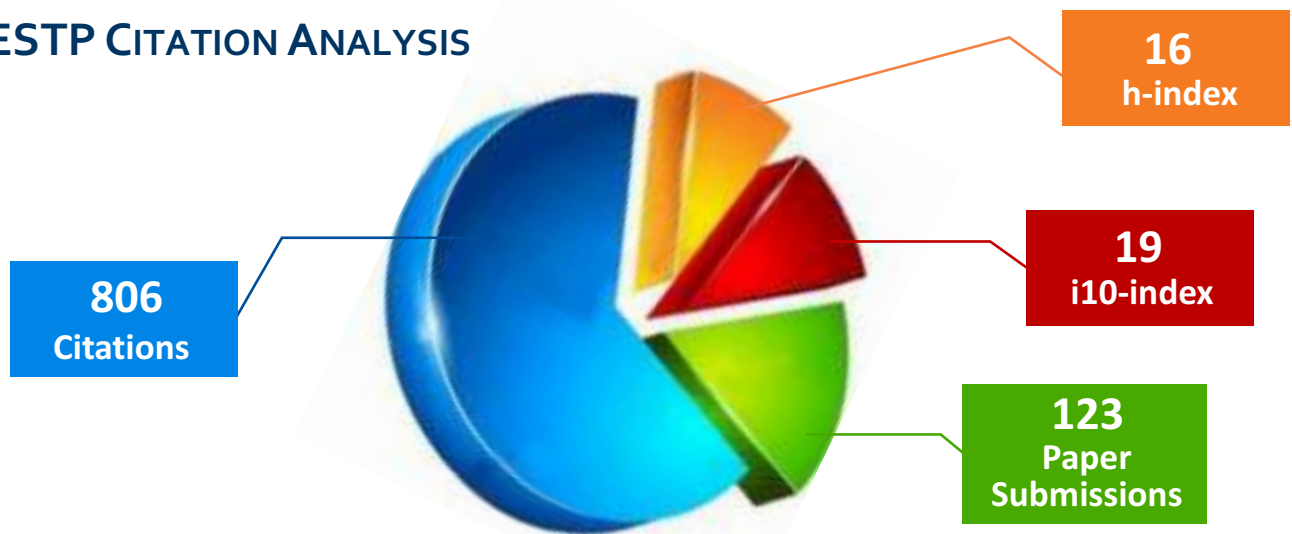

Training sessions were organised for the office of Controller of Examinations and the librarians of the College on the different modules of college ERP Sonet .

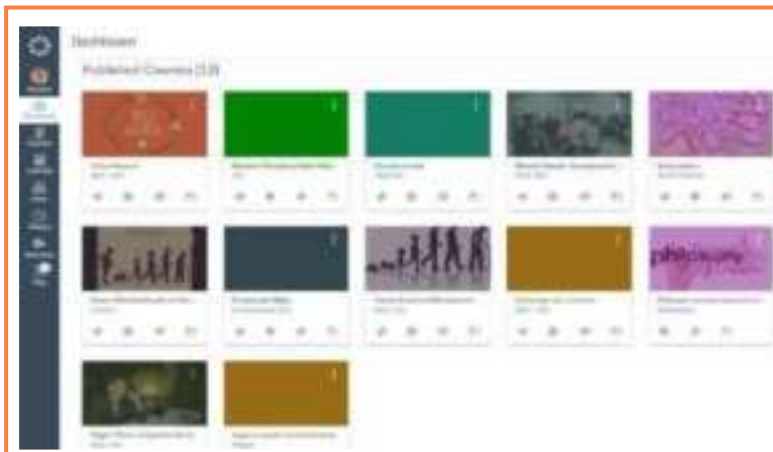

An online Jingle Writing competition was organized on the theme "Youth in 2021" on 28th September 28, 2021 to celebrate NSS Day.

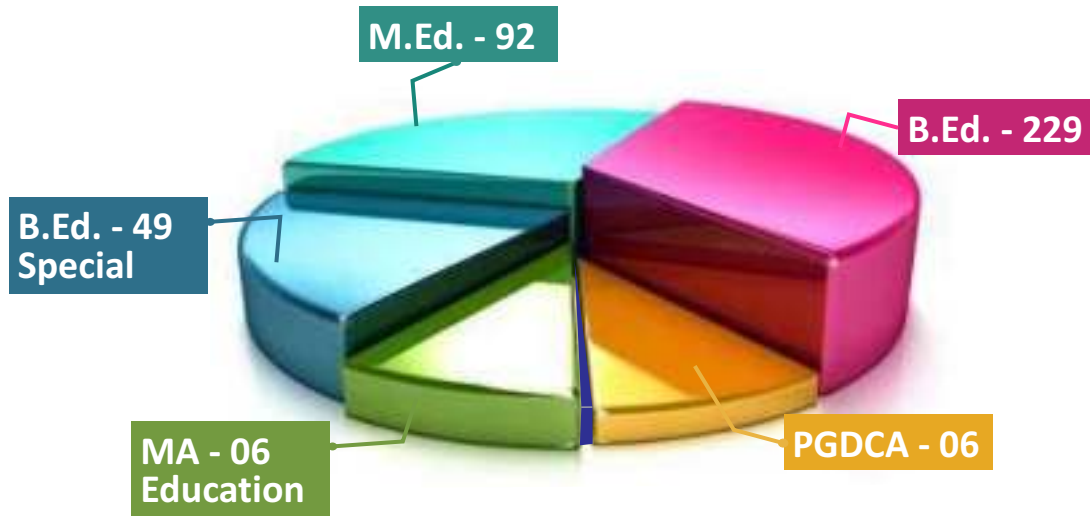
NSS CAMP
