
## **New Programmes**

## **Launch of Access Microscholarship Program**








## **Research Studies**

Prof. Mool Raj, Head, Centre for Educational Technology conducted two research studies for the implementation of TEL project supported by Commonwealth of Learning (COL).

The first study was conducted with the objective of developing Technology Enabled Learning policy and implementing it with the support of COL.

The second study assessed the effectiveness of blended learning (BL) on the learning performance of the students of MIER College of Education and their perceptions about it.





## **Grant Received**



The Commonwealth of Learning (COL) has awarded a grant of Rupees 9.5 lakh to the college for the development of one year Diploma in ICT in Education and conducting workshops on Moodle administration under the phase three of the TEL project. The COL grant is given in recognition of college's efforts to provide quality ICT education and training to educators. The grant will enable the college to develop and deliver high-quality programmes that will benefit educators and students across the region. The Diploma in ICT in Education shall be started in the 2024 session.

An orientation programme on the Technology Enhanced Learning (TEL) Policy framed in collaboration with the Commonwealth of Learning (COL) was organised on September 18, 2023. The orientation was aimed at familiarizing staff members with the policy guidelines and preparing them for its effective implementation.



## Interaction with Parents



## **GREEN INITIATIVES**

MIER College has implemented a rainwater harvesting system as part of its College Environmental Policy, promoting eco-friendly living practices and environmental sustainability.

The water is collected from rooftops, diverted, and stored in a 2000 litre tank. The water is then used to irrigate the college lawns, gardens and to wash down the pathways and parking lot.

The College aims to harvest and store large quantity of water by installing more such set ups in a phased manner.





To promote the use of solar energy, three solar lights were installed in the college campus to brighten pathways, parking areas, and ground. This initiative aligns with the college environmental policy and demonstrates a proactive approach to promoting renewable energy.

A webinar on the theme "Plastic Waste Management" and an awareness session on the theme "Solid Waste Management and Vermi-Composting" was organised on December 20, 2022.
