INTRODUCTION: The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is a vital part of the institution's quality assurance system and has been continuously working towards ensuring quality enhancement and sustenance. Descriptive Feedback

Overall, 91.84% of the students are satisfied with the curriculum and its delivery. Majority of the students (97.96%) agree that the programme and course learning outcomes are well-defined. A combined total of 89.79% of students find the curriculum topics relevant and interesting, indicating strong engagement. The small neutral percentage (10.20%) reflects scope for further alignment with student interests. The responses received from the students highlighted that overall, the curriculum is good and enriches the inherent talent of the students and helps them to achieve their aims. With the help of the curriculum, students have attained interesting learning experiences.

Major Observations/Suggestions given by students:

- 1. The balance of theoretical and practical components throughout the semesters needs adjustment, as the first year seems overly theoretical while the second-year leans too heavily on practical aspects.
- 2. Given the emphasis on teaching practice, the curriculum should prioritize practical learning experiences over excessive theoretical content.
- 3. There's a desire for more enriching experiences, including field trips and educational outings, to broaden knowledge and skills.
- 4. Incorporating more hands-on activities into the curriculum would enhance engagement and learning outcomes.
- 5. Rather than traditional written sessional work, students suggest alternative assessments like creative projects to better showcase their abilities.
- 6. At times, the convergence of examinations and internship tasks poses challenges for students, suggesting a need for a more streamlined curriculum.





Descriptive Feedback

90% of the students are satisfied with the curriculum and its delivery. 100% of the students feel supported by the teaching methods used, indicating effective instructional strategies. While 85% agree that the curriculum addresses different learning styles, 15% are neutral or disagree, suggesting that diverse instructional approaches should be adopted. The responses received from the students highlighted that overall, the curriculum has been designed according to the needs and interests of the students.

Major Observations/Suggestions given by students:

- 1. More opportunities should be provided for hands-on learning.
- 2. Field experiences in special education classrooms, practicums with students with intellectual disabilities, and opportunities to participate in research projects should be increased both in number and frequency.




