



Diploma in ICT in Education



A Diploma in ICT in Education has been launched in hybrid mode, designed for inservice teachers and students seeking to upgrade their ICT knowledge. Developed in collaboration with the Commonwealth of Learning, Canada, the course includes recorded lessons, providing comprehensive training.

Infrastructure Upgraded

The digital infrastructure has been upgraded with a state-of-the-art recording studio to facilitate lecture recordings for digital content creation, enhancing teaching and learning. Additionally, CCTV cameras have been installed to strengthen campus security. New faculty members have been provided with essential IT resources, ensuring seamless integration into the institution's technologically advanced academic environment.

Workshop / Training Programmes

A collaborative webinar titled "Developing Interactive Open Textbooks for Indian School Education" was hosted by KBR & HL Human Development Foundation and Centre for Educational Technology on March 07, 2024. The webinar aimed to explore innovative approaches to creating interactive educational resources for Indian school students.





Under Phase III, COL project, a two-day workshop on Moodle Learning Management System for Effective Blended Learning was held on March 18-19, 2024. Dr. Indira Koneru, was the resource person. The workshop aimed to enhance the administration and management skills of educators in blended learning environments.

A 2-day workshop on SPSS, held on April 15-16, 2024, trained M.Ed. Semester III students in data analysis techniques like descriptive statistics, correlation, and regression.

Workshop / Training Programmes



A workshop on the College ERP system, Radical Logix, was organized on September from 12 to 13, 2024, where faculty members from both the School of Education and the School of Social Sciences and Humanities received comprehensive training. The sessions covered various modules, aiming to streamline administrative tasks and enhance overall efficiency in academic management.

The Centre organized an online session, Canva Amplified: Level 1, on September 20, 2024. Ms. Vrushali Sheth, Co-Founder & Head of Product at OrangeSlate, Pune assessed faculty skills for integrating Canva into teaching.

This was followed by a hands-on workshop on September 25, 2024, where Ms. Sheth trained faculty in advanced Canva tools, enhancing their design skills for educational and professional purposes.





A two-day workshop on Google Classroom was organized for the new batch of BA (FYUP), MA Psychology, and MA Political Science students from October 22–23, 2024. Dr. Monika Bajaj conducted the enrollment sessions, while Prof. Mool Raj and Mr. Sanjay Chandel led sessions on Google Classroom features and hands-on practice.

Students Induction Programme

The College hosted a engaging induction programme for new students from the School of Social Sciences and Humanities and the School of Education. The event included expert lectures and interactive sessions such as student introductions, talent-sharing activities, and engaging games. New students were oriented to the course curriculum, various centres, and committees. College alumni shared their experiences, offering insights and inspiration.













Staff Induction Programme



On April 4, 2024, the IQAC organized an orientation programme for newly appointed College staff. The session provided an overview of the College's mission, organizational structure, academic guidelines, and procedures. New employees were also introduced to the College's service rules and the Facto HR leave and attendance system to facilitate a smooth onboarding process.

Open Forum Interactions



In its commitment to creating a student-centric learning environment, the IQAC conducted the open forum interactions with third-semester undergraduate and postgraduate students on December 18, 2023 to gather unfiltered feedback from students on various aspects of their academic experiences, examinations, faculty interactions, and extracurricular activities. The session encouraged open dialogue, allowing students to share honest opinions and concerns.

Interaction with Parents

The "Tea with Principal" programme held on October 19, 2024, provided an opportunity for parents of students of the College to engage in meaningful dialogue with the management. During the session, parents discussed a range of curricular and co-curricular matters, raising suggestions, questions, and concerns. The event facilitated a constructive exchange of feedback and ideas.



Stakeholders Feedback

The IQAC conducted a Student Satisfaction Survey and collected curriculum feedback from students of the School of Education (Batch 2022–2024) and the School of Social Sciences and Humanities (Batch 2022–2026) using PI 360 Data Analytical software. The survey provided valuable insights into their academic experiences. The collected data identified areas of concern, highlighted strengths, and served as a foundation for developing an action plan to address the issues effectively.

Advisory Committee Meeting

Ms. Jasleen Mohial, Coordinator, IQAC presented a comprehensive review of the performance of the cell and sought valuable suggestions from external experts during the Advisory Committee Meeting on April 26, 2023.

The meeting offered a platform for valuable recommendations aimed at enhancing the efficiency and effectiveness of the operations of the cell.



NAAC Orientation

The orientation sessions were conducted for faculty and students to familiarize them with the NAAC re-accreditation process in the month of February, 2024. The sessions addressed the evaluation criteria and the importance of accreditation for the institution. Faculty learned about the assessment parameters, while students were informed about the accreditation process and their role in the student satisfaction survey.







Internal Audit

The College conducted a comprehensive internal audit to assess adherence to its quality management system and prepare for the upcoming NAAC 4th cycle reaccreditation on March 29 to April 1, 2024. Identified nonconformities were communicated to relevant departments, who were tasked with implementing corrective actions to meet established standards.

Life Skills Programmes





A four-day personality development workshop was held for the students of School of Social Sciences and Humanities from December 19 to 22, 2023. Led by a master trainer, Mrs. Abha Chaudhary, alumna of the College the workshop focused on communication, self-confidence, etiquette, and personal branding. 


Health Talk

GREEN INITIATIVES

In a significant stride towards sustainability, the College has installed 10 MW solar panels on campus, reinforcing its commitment to renewable energy. These panels generate electricity efficiently, helping the institution reduce its carbon footprint while promoting eco-friendly practices.

Beyond self-sufficiency, the solar energy system allows the College to save on electricity costs and contribute excess power back to the grid, supporting a cleaner and greener future.





On November 6, 2023, the Environment Unit, in collaboration with Jammu Municipal Corporation, organized a Swacchata Abhiyan at Purkhoo village. The cleanliness drive raised awareness about cleanliness and discourage open defecation. Students educated residents on waste management, segregation, disposal, and personal hygiene.

A visit to Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology (SKUAST), Jammu was organised on December 7, 2023 to educate students on sustainable agriculture, innovative methods, and the importance of vermi composting in modern farming practices.












National Level Achievements
