QUALIFICATIONS & ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE POSITION OF ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR & ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

Associate Professor:

Essential Qualification:

- i) Master's degree in any discipline with not less than 50% of marks.
- ii) M.Ed. Degree in Intellectual Disability (ID) area with not less than 55% of marks Or an equivalent grade of B+ in 10- point scale of UGC.
OR
An equivalent degree from a foreign university recognized by RCI.
- iii) Ph.D. in Special Education or Education with research emphasis on Special Education.
- iv) Should have completed at least 08 years of teaching experience as faculty out of which minimum 05 years should be in specific disability area.
- v) Should have completed at least one General Orientation Course and two Refresher Courses in education/special education of UGC.
- vi) Valid registration with RCI u/s 19 of RCI Act, 1992 is essential.

Desirable:

Minimum 03 publications pertaining to Special Education in indexed journals and research experience.

Assistant Professor:

Essential Qualification:

- i) Master's degree in any discipline with not less than 50% of marks.
- ii) M.Ed. Degree in Intellectual Disability (ID) area with not less than 55% of marks Or an equivalent grade of B+ in 10- point scale of UGC.

OR

An equivalent degree from a foreign university recognized by RCI.

Valid registration with RCI u/s 19 of RCI Act, 1992 is essential.

Desirable:

M.Phil./Ph.D. in Special Education or Education with research emphasis on special Education; Experience for a period of at least 2 years as teacher or researcher in the area of specific disability.
