B. Four year Undergraduate Honours Programme

- iii) Bachelor of Sociology (Honours/Research)
- iv) Bachelor of Pol. Science (Honours/Research)

Candidates desirous of seeking admission are required to register themselves online on the College website www.miercollege.in. and fill up the Online Application Form with an application fee of Rs.1000/-as per the procedure provided on the portal. The details are also provided on the website for the convenience of the applicants. Applicants facing difficulty in submitting the online application forms or seeking any clarification and assistance can visit the College Admission Cell between 10 am to 4 pm. Candidates can also submit the downloaded form and all documents along with a Demand Draft for Rs. 1000/- in favour of "MIER College of Education" payable at Jammu through Registered Post/Speed Post/Courier.

Eligibility for admission to M.Ed. & M.A. (Education)

A candidate seeking admission to M.Ed. Programme should have obtained atleast 50 % marks in the aggregate (45 % for candidates belonging to SC/ST Category) or an equivalent grade in any of the following programmes: i) B.Ed. ii) 4-year Integrated B.A. B.Ed., B.Sc. B.Ed. iii) B.El.Ed. iv) D.El.Ed. with an undergraduate degree (with 50% marks in each)	A candidate seeking admission to M.A. (Education) Programme must have passed the Bachelor's Degree Examination (10+2+3 pattern) / Semester pattern in any discipline from a recognized University / Institution with atleast 40% marks in aggregate (36% for SC/ST candidates).	

Eligibility for admission to M.Ed. Special Education (ID)

The admission for the degree of M.Ed. Spl. Education (ID). degree shall be open to:

- a) A candidate who has successfully passed B.Ed Spl. Education (ID). with minimum 50% marks from a recognized university or any other degree considered equivalent to B.Ed Spl. Education (ID) from an affiliating university and/or teaching department under any University recognized by U.G.C. with RCI / registration.
- b) A candidate who has successfully passed the B.Ed. General Course and has successfully completed Diploma in Special Education (ID) recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India with minimum 50 percent marks in each course.
- c) A candidate having passed PG Diploma (Till academic session 2014-15)
- d) Candidate should have valid RCI registration.

Eligibility for admission to B.Ed. & B. Ed. Spl. Education (ID)

B. Ed.

Admission to the B.Ed. Course shall be open to candidates:

With at least 50 % marks (45 % for SC/ST Candidates) either in the Bachelor's Degree OR in the Master's Degree in Sciences / Social Sciences / Humanities. Candidates holding the degree Engineering or Technology with Specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55 % marks (50 % marks for reserved categories) or any other qualification equivalent thereto from a recognized University shall also be eligible

B. Ed. Spl. Education Intellectual Disability (ID)

Admission to the B.Ed. Special Education (ID) Course shall be open to candidates with at least **50** % marks (45 % for SC/ST Candidates) either in the Bachelor's Degree or in the Master's Degree in Sciences / Social Sciences / Humanities.

Candidates holding degree in Engineering or Technology with Specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks (50% for reserved categories) or any other qualification equivalent thereto from a recognized University shall also be eligible.

(This course is approved by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) and is aimed at training students to teach mentally retarded children in both normal & special schools)

Eligibility for admission to Four year Undergraduate Honours Programme

Candidate seeking admission to the Bachelor of English (Honours / Research) must have obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for candidates belonging to reserved categories in Higher Secondary Part-II Examination (under 10+2 pattern) of Jammu and Kashmir State Board of School Education, Central Board of Secondary Education or an examination recognised as equivalent thereto from any other recognised Board.

Note:

- 1. The candidates who have appeared or appearing in the qualifying examination can also apply.
- 2. The candidates are advised to deposit their marks certificates of the final year/semester of the qualifying examination either in the College or through Registered/Speed Post or Scanned copy through e-mail after the declaration of the result. However, their admission shall be regularized after submission of the requisite documents such as final year Marks card/Provisional certificate.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

M.Ed.

Admission shall be made on the basis of Academic Merit of the qualifying examination from any recognized University/ Board i.e. B.Ed. / 4-year Integrated B.A., B.Ed., B.Sc. / B.Ed. / B.El.Ed. /D.El.Ed. with an undergraduate degree (with 50% marks in each).

M.Ed. Special Education (ID)

Admission to the M.Ed. Spl. Education (ID) shall be made on the basis of an Entrance Test and academic merit in the qualifying examination. The final merit shall be determined by giving a weightage of 30 % to the marks obtained in the Entrance Test and 70 % to the academic merit of the qualifying examination OR any other criteria prescribed by the Competent Authority from time to time.

M.A. (Education)

Admission shall be made on the basis of Academic Merit of the qualifying examination from any recognized University i.e. Bachelor's Degree in any discipline.

B.Ed. & B. Ed. Spl. Education (ID)

- a) 75% of the sanctioned seats available in the College shall be filled from amongst the eligible candidates who:
 - i) are Graduates or Post-Graduates of the University of Jammu;

OR

ii) belong to areas falling within the territorial jurisdiction of the University of Jammu but have passed the qualifying examination from a University other than the University of Jammu.

OR

iii) Such employees of the Central/State Govt./Public Sector Undertakings or any other Organization recognized by the University of Jammu as are posted within the territorial jurisdiction of the University of Jammu or wards (sons, daughters or spouses) of such employees.

Provided further that wards of Kashmiri migrants in other parts of the Country are also eligible for admission to the B.Ed./B.Ed. Special Education (ID) Course under Local Category of the admission within the 75% of the sanctioned seats in order of merit, provided such a candidate produces a documentary evidence of belonging to a family registered as Kashmiri Migrant.

b) The remaining 25% seats shall be filled from amongst the eligible candidates who neither belong to the territorial jurisdiction of the University of Jammu nor have passed the qualifying examination from the University of Jammu.

Undergraduate Honours Programme

Admission to the Bachelor of English (Honours / Research) shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination from any recognised Board/Institution or any other mode to be prescribed by the University of Jammu/J&K Government from time to time.

Reservation of Seats

Reservation of seats shall be as per Reservation Policy of Jammu& Kashmir Government/University of Jammu as notified from time to time.

Left Over Seats

In case of a vacant seat under a reserved category for want of eligible candidates the same shall be offered to the candidate of non-reserved category (open merit) in order of merit.

M.Ed. Programme

- 1. Secondary School or an equivalent examination certificate
- 2. Marks Certificates of the qualifying examination
- 3. Provisional Certificate issued by the institution last attended
- 4. Category Certificate (if applicable)
- 5. Migration Certificate for the candidates not registered with MIER College of Education(Autonomous). However, the candidates may produce the Migration Certificate within a period of 30 days from the date of their admission
- 6. Affidavits as per the specimen available with the Admission Cell of the College

M.A. (Education)

- 1. Secondary school or an equivalent examination certificate
- 2. Marks Certificate of each part/semester of graduation
- 3. Provisional Certificate issued by the institution last attended
- 4. Category Certificate (if applicable)
- 5. Migration Certificate for the candidates not registered with MIER College of Education(Autonomous). However, the candidates may produce the Migration Certificate within a period of 30 days from the date of their admission
- 6. Affidavits as per the specimen available with the Admission Cell of the College

B.Ed. & B. Ed. Spl. Education (ID)

- i) Secondary School or equivalent examination certificate
- ii) Marks Certificates of the qualifying examination
- iii) Degree/Provisional Certificate issued by the Institution/University last attended
- iv) Marks Certificate of each part of the qualifying examination
- v) Certificate of a good conduct from the Principal of the College / Head of the institution or any Gazetted Officer

- vi) Category Certificate issued by the Competent Authority as per the latest SRO issued by the J&K State Government (if applicable)
- vii) Domicile Certificate of being Permanent Resident of the State of Jammu and Kashmir issued by the Competent Authority by the candidates who:
 - a) passed the qualifying examination from a University other than the University of Jammu but belong to the areas falling within the territorial jurisdiction of the University of Jammu and claim consideration for admission to the course
 - b) Claim consideration for admission under any of the reserved categories
- viii) Migration Certificate for the candidates not registered with MIER College of Education (Autonomous). However, the candidate may produce the migration certificate within a period of 30 days from the date of their admission.
- ix) Affidavits as per the specimen available with the Admission Cell of the College

M.Ed. Special Education (ID)

All the selected candidates shall submit the following self-attested documents at the time of admission to the M.Ed. Spl. Education (ID) Programme:

- i) Matriculation or equivalent examination certificate
- ii) Marks certificate of each part/semester of the qualifying examination
- iii) Provisional Certificate/Degree issued by the University/Institution last attended
- iv) Category Certificate (If applicable) issued by the Competent Authority as per the latest SRO issued by the J&K Govt.
- v) Certificate of being "**Domicile**" of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir issued by the Competent Authority by the candidates seeking admission under any of the reserved categories
- vi) Migration Certificate in case the candidate is not already registered with MIER College of Education (Autonomous)
- vii) Affidavits duly attested by a First Class Magistrate or a Notary Public as per the specimen available in the Admission Cell of the College

Undergraduate Honours Programme

All the selected candidates shall submit the following self-attested documents at the time of their admission to the Bachelor of English (Honours / Research) Programme:

- i) Matriculation or equivalent examination certificate
- i) Marks Certificate of each part of the qualifying examination
- ii) Provisional and Migration/Transfer Certificate issued by the Institution/Board last attended
- ii) Category Certificate (If applicable) issued by the Competent Authority as per the latest SRO issued by the J&K Government
- iii) Certificate of being "**Domicile**" of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir issued by the Competent Authority (in case a candidate seeks admission under reserved category)
- vi) Affidavits duly attested by a First-Class Magistrate or a Notary Public as per the specimen available in the Admission Cell of the College.

Important Note

The certificates of candidates belonging to reserved categories who are permanent residents of the Union Territory of J&K shall not be entertained if these do not conform to the latest SRO/Order issued by the J&K Government for the purpose. In case, a candidate claims admission under reserved category but does not attach the requisite certificate in support of his/her claim with the Application Form and if found otherwise eligible, will be considered under Open Merit Category. No certificate or attested copy thereof will be entertained after the last date notified for admission. The claim of the candidate for consideration under any reserved category with "under process certificate" of category shall not be entertained.

Award of Degree

The degree shall be awarded to the successful candidates by the University of Jammu. However, the Marks, Provisional and Migration Certificates shall be issued by the College
